The British Riding Club movement consists of 23 areas throughout Great Britain, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Each riding club belongs to an area, hence ours is Area 2. As well as holding qualifiers for Riding Club championships which are held in different parts of the country, we hold competitions throughout the winter which is a points league, which each club can submit teams and individuals to take part. This year we are holding an open Arena Eventing competitions for juniors and seniors which will be the last mounted competition of the series. Our series ends with a quiz which is held at South Causey Inn, prizes, and Easter Eggs are the prizes on the night.

Team Managers.

It is recommended that each club provides a team manager who is able to remain with their team throughout the day, this is partly due for health and safety reasons, in the event of an accident, someone can take responsibility for that person, horse, etc. It also allows your team members to be introduced to each other and feel part of the team that is representing their club.

COMPETITORS CONDUCT AT COMPETITIONS

As a competitor you need to be aware of your responsibilities.

- Be courteous to all stewards and helpers, they like you are Riding Club members who have given up their time so you can compete.
- It is your responsibility to know the rules of the competition, riding club rules do vary from other disciplines, all rules can be viewed on the British Riding Club website. www.britishridingclubs.co.uk and also the rule book can be downloaded from this site.
- The owners of each venue have spent time preparing the premises for us to use, so please respect any of their wishes regarding the use of the venue.
- You are responsible for making sure that your vaccinations for your horse/pony are up to date.
- Anyone who is verbally abusive to any other rider, steward or helper, will be asked to leave and their score will be withdrawn from the competition.
- FaceBook aggression will not be tolerated, if topics need to be addressed, please do this privately via person to person, phone or email.
- When you have finished your part in the competition, please bear in mind that scorers and officials do their best to get the score out as quickly as possible, and any offer of help from yourselves would be gratefully received, either in delivering drinks, collecting score sheets.

FLU INJECTIONS.

All horses/ponies that take part in British Riding Club competitions whether locally or nationally, must produce their passports with an up to date records of the animal's injections

The certificate must have the first three injections entered together with the annual up to date injection. If the passport or certificate is found to be out of date, the rider will be allowed to ride HC, until the passport is proved to be correct or incorrect, the score of that person will be allowed if correct or disregarded if incorrect, and that will have bearing on the team score and position. Scanned in passports will be allowed if sent by evening of the competition.

Flu certificates will be accepted with the first two injections.

Helping at the competitions

All clubs have to help at the competitions that they enter. We do our very best to keep this to a minimum, but without this help, we could not continue. We do have a selection of volunteers who are willing to help the area, and we do call upon these, but a rota of help will be at the back of this schedule, any clubs who feel that they cannot do the task asked, please come back to Hilary as soon as possible, not 2 days before the competition.

80cm **Show Jumping Qualifier and Intermediate Show Jumping Qualifier – 18th February 2018**



This competition will consist of two rounds, the first round will not be timed, but the second round will be timed. If a jump off is required, then all four horses will be required to jump, individual clear rounds will also be required to jump off.

1st Round will be 80cm

2nd round will be 85cm.

Horses or ponies not to have won any BS money, except notional points gained in club classes held at BS intro shows. Horses cannot have competed at intermediate or open show jumping at National Championships in the same competition year. Horses cannot compete in both Novice Winter Championships and Intermediate Winter Championships. A horse cannot jump the same course of jumps more than once in the same day. <u>There is no individual competition</u>

Intermediate Show Jumping qualifier. 18th February 2018

Equi•Thème

Horses that take part in this competition **may not** compete in the Novice Show Jumping qualifier.

All four riders and horses jump 90cm in the 1st round

2nd round will be 95cm

If a jump off is necessary, all four horses will take part, individual clears may need to jump off too.
